



Authorized Teachers

Please distribute the Kids Voting Hawaii Student Password Cards to your students **for the “For Real” General Election Oct. 19 - Nov. 2, 2010**. Please keep the Student Password Cards and lists in a safe & secure place until distribution.

Questions and Answers:

1. What should I do if a student loses a password?

- The student should see his/her teacher from whom the Student Password Card was received.
- If the teacher has a list of the Passwords issued with student names, the teacher may have the student write down the same Student Password.
- If the teacher has extra Student Password Cards, the student may be given one of the extra Student Password Cards.
- If the teacher does not have a list or extra passwords, he/she should request one from the School Level Ambassador (SLA).

2. What should I do if a new student enrolls?

- The Authorized Teacher (AT) should give the student an unassigned Student Password Card.
- If the AT does not have extra Student Password Cards, he/she should request one from the SLA.

3. What should I do when a student leaves the school?

You don't need to do anything.

4. How will I know if a student voted?

- When a student submits a ballot, there will be a congratulatory message, which he/she should print as “proof of voting.”
- Authorized Teachers will not be able to check the School Password List to see if students have voted. Only School Level Ambassadors may check that list.

5. What if the Student Password does not work?

- Give the student an unassigned Student Password Card. If you do not have extra Student Password Cards, request one from the SLA.
