

Student Voting Instructions

Voting can be done on any computer with Internet access.

- √ September 27-October 17: Practice Voting. No Student Password needed but you must know your Voting District & Precinct numbers.
- √ October 19-November 2: Official (for real) voting. Before “for real” voting one of your teachers will give you a Student Voter Password card. You will use the Student Password to login for official voting along with your Voting District & Precinct numbers.
- √ November 2 (Election Day): No “walk-in” voting at polling places. You may vote on any computer with Internet access if you have not already done so.
- √ It is advisable that you use current Internet browser versions such as Internet Explorer 7, Firefox 3, or Safari 3. Avoid using Internet Explorer 6 or older versions for security reasons.

Practice Voting (September 27 - October 17, 2010)

1. Go to the Kids Voting Hawaii website kidsvotinghawaii.org
2. Click on the “Voting Booth” tab.
3. Go to Step 6 if you know your District and Precinct number.
If you don’t, click on “Find Your Polling Place” link.

Practice Voting September 27 to October 17.

Practice Voting is open! You don’t need a Student Password to practice. You will need your family’s voter district and precinct numbers. If you don’t know them, [click here](#). Then click x in the top corner to come back to the Voting Booth.

4. Find Your Polling Place: Click the arrow next to the box under “County” if you need to change it to your county (Oahu, Hawaii, Kauai or Maui). Type in the name of the street on which you live (or your school’s street). Do not type in number and type of street (ex. Street, Place, Way etc.) Then type in your zip code. Click “Find It”.

Find Your Polling Place!

Your polling place and the candidates you will vote for are determined by your residence address. Use this search inquiry to find your polling place.
If you are unable to obtain a result, please click on [<Help>](#) for instructions. If you do not have a street address, please contact the Office of the City/County Clerk.

5. Write down only the District and Precinct number. If there is more than one street listed, pick the correct one based on street type &/or polling place. Click x in top corner to close window and return to “Practice Voting” page.
6. Click on the island on which you live. Type in your District & Precinct numbers. Click appropriate grade level box: Grades K-3 or Grades 4-12. Click “Request Ballot.” The ballot will appear; the same one your parents will see.

During the practice voting period, it is suggested that you print the ballot to discuss with others, learn about candidates, and mark your votes.

“For Real” Voting (October 19-November 2, 2010)

7. Go to the Kids Voting Hawaii website, and click on “Voting Booth” tab. Click the island you live on. Then login with your Student Password and District & Precinct numbers. Click appropriate grade level: Grades K-3 or Grades 4-12. Note: If you do not know your district or precinct, click on “Find Your Polling Place” & follow steps 4 & 5.
8. The ballot will appear and you will input your votes for candidates and issues on the computer. Your vote will count when you click on “Submit.”
9. After submitting your ballot, a congratulatory message will appear which may be printed to verify that you have voted.
10. Close out of the browser: Click on x in right corner (PCs) - in left corner (Macs).
